Program Tip

Rights in a federally registered trademark can last indefinitely as long as the owner continues to use the mark to identify its goods or services and files all necessary documentation in the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office. Between the fifth and sixth years after registration, the owner must file a "Declaration of Continued Use or Excusable Nonuse" to avoid cancellation of the registration.
