Dedicated Tax Counsel Assists Nonprofits with Complex Federal Laws
and Procedures

Anthony J. Distinti is a tax associate at Stroock & Stroock & Lavan LLP. He received a B.A. from Haverford College in 2001, an M.Ed. from Lehman College in 2004, his J.D. from Fordham University School of Law in 2007, and his LL.M. in Tax from New York University School of Law in 2010.

Mr. Distinti has been providing legal assistance to **Sixth Street Community Center** (the Center) in addressing not-for-profit organization compliance issues and audit requirements pertaining to its Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) and other programs. The Center, located on the Lower East Side, offers a variety of free arts, writing, gardening, afterschool, and summer programs for low- and moderateincome youth, as well as the CSA, which provides 150 neighborhood households with fresh organic produce on a weekly basis.
